Bids may only be submitted on the bid documentation issued by the Municipality.</li> <li>3. The Municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or to re-advertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The Municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest tender or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points or if it is the only tender. The Municipality reserves the right to cancel or withdraw the request for tender at anytime without prior notice.</li> <li>4. Tenders are subject to the Kannaland Municipality Supply Chain Management Policy.</li> <li>5. This tender will be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 preference point system as prescribed in the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2022. The original forms must be completed and submitted together with your tender.</li> <li>6. An original or certified B-BBEE certificate, or certified Sworn Affidavit must be submitted with your tender offer. If it's not an original or certified copy it will not be taken into consideration for preference points.</li> <li>7. The maximum points awarded for price and the maximum points for preference, shall be 80 and 20.</li> <li>8. A valid tax compliance pin number on an official document of SARS in order for the municipality to verify tax compliance must be submitted with the tender document.</li> <li>9. Potential service providers must be registered on the Central Supplier Database. The Municipality reserves the right not to award tenders to Bidders who are not registered on the Database.</li> <li>10. Potential service providers who were found guilty of fraud or corruption or who willfully neglected, reneged on or failed to comply with any government, municipal or other public sector contract during the past five years, will be excluded from this process.</li> <li>11.
